Form+ Content Gallery presents *planet waves*, an exhibition of paintings by Howard Oransky. The exhibition consists of seven artworks, made with oil-on-canvas, on the theme of water as a metaphor of experience. The exhibition is anchored by one large

diptych (double-paneled artwork) measuring 8 feet high by 12 feet wide, placed on the back wall of the gallery. Six smaller diptychs, three on each side of the gallery, complete the installation. The paintings are composed of many small gestures that together form a system of color, light and movement. For Oransky, painting is like an ocean -- an endless expanse of possibilities. This exhibition is dedicated with love to the memory of Jacob Igra.

Artist Statement

I'd like to make some paintings that convey the way we experience the world – first, a perception of the surface, which appears unified and seamless, then a deeper, more nuanced gathering of many small moments, many small gestures. Howard Oransky

Howard Oransky was born in Los Angeles, and received an MFA in painting at California Institute of the Arts. His work has been shown in over 100 exhibitions nationally and is included in numerous public and private collections.
