(Minneapolis, MN) – Form + Content Gallery presents *Transient/Enduring*, an exhibition of installation and drawings by Sandra Menefee Taylor. Her mixed media works transform common materials such as paper, dirt, light and shadow into a luminous and multi-layered installation that seeks to connect past and present, with implications for who we are today.

Sandra Menefee Taylor: Artist Statement

My work explores and considers the connections of life—the world as a <u>whole</u>. I see nature and culture as a continuum, rather than a dichotomy. So I am drawn to materials that are clearly 'worldly' (such as dirt and gravity) and to images that speak of our human fascination with patterns and light. The work arises not from nostalgia but from a desire to acknowledge the enduring presence of mystery.

Sandra Menefee Taylor: Artist Biography

Sandra Menefee Taylor is an independent studio artist based in Saint Paul. Her work takes many forms, ranging from installation and mixed-media paintings to performance, video, and artist books. She has created installations for the Weisman Art Museum, University of Saint Catherine, Grinnell College and the Phipps Art Center. Her work is included in the collections of the Metropolitan Museum of Art, Walker Art Center, the Minneapolis Institute of Arts, and other museums and private collections nationwide. She holds a BFA from the Minneapolis College of Art and Design.

Taylor is currently working with the Wilder Foundation, teaching painting to people with memory loss, where she is discovering that the creative process can give "a new voice" to those who are moving through an often-fearsome transition in life. In addition she will be featured in a solo show as part of the "Mothers of Invention" series at the Plains Art Museum, Fargo ND opening June 12.
